### **Recent Dock Installation:**

### **Before Pictures:**



As our dock service and installation business continues to grow, so does the complimentary services we need to provide the customer in order to meet the many unique requirements. Pictured above is a recent project we've completed - on the left is a dock leveler and pit angle that was beyond repair and ultimately unsafe to use. The pit angles that wrap the outer edge of the concrete pit were loose and bent causing the forks of the fork truck to catch on it, making the situation worse. Additionally the dock itself was very rusty and structurally fatigued. The solution was to remove the dock leveler and cut out the damaged pit angle and concrete from the perimeter of the pit, and then rebuild the pit. With the new concrete pit poured and the pit angle hardened into place, we then installed a new Nordock mechanical dock leveler thereby restoring both the structural and operational safety of the loading dock position.

These problems as pictured aren't unique to one or two places, and if they exist at your facility don't hesitate to give us a call to help repair the damaged concrete, big or small, to ensure the safety of all involved as well as extend the life of existing equipment.
