Body Shop Division

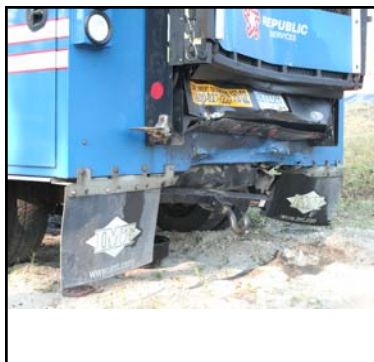

Recent Speed-Tech Projects:

➡ Featured Project is our most recent Loading Dock Equipment project with A.J. Veneklasen in West Michigan.

➡ This project entailed mechanical dock levelers, mechanical trailer restraints and dock seals. We filled this need with the Nordock Industrial Series Mechanical leveler with their 20 year front and rear hinge warranty, along with a 10 year structural deck warranties. To ensure full safety in loading and unloading their trailers, this customer also ordered the MTL 250 trailer restraints. These are mechanically operated but with the added feature of automatic communication lights. These are great for those budgeted projects that want to still ensure proper safety measures for automatic communication lights in their loading areas.

➡ We recently finished up a very unique project for a customer. We were asked if we would refurbish a large, heavy duty truck ramp that was about 10' wide x 30' long. This ramp was recessed in the floor, pivoting on one end and was raised and lowered with a very large hydraulic cylinder. The purpose of this ramp was to raise and level off trucks that backed up to a loading dock. This particular site had a very steep decline away from the dock so trucks would back up onto this ramp. The ramp would raise up and level the trucks making it much safer to load and off-load trucks from the dock with a fork-lift. We had a crane on site to help lift and load on a truck. We then transported it to our shop. We completely stripped the lift down to the structural framework, sandblasted, refurbished and rebuilt ramp, primed and painted. We also rebuilt the hydraulic cylinders, delivered and reinstalled. In addition to this we supplied and installed a new dock lift!

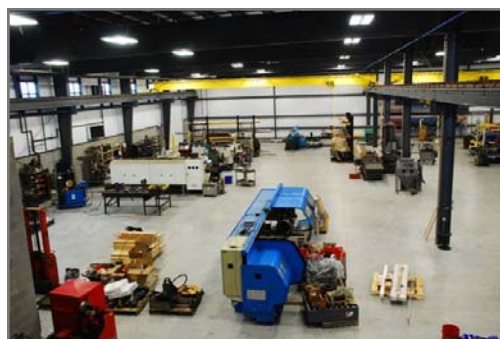
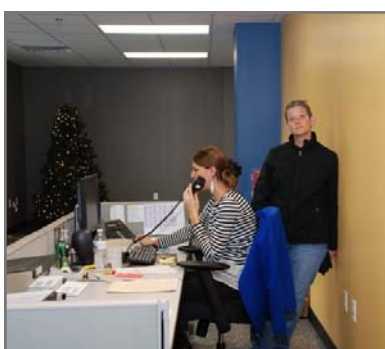
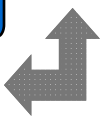
